SENIOR QUOTE GUIDELINES

The deadline to submit your senior quote is December 2, 2022!

Your quote should be well chosen and represent your best qualities, as it will serve as a record of who you are for years to come. The quote will help others remember you after graduation. If the quote is ambiguous or has a negative connotation, the yearbook adviser and/or school administration will have the right to determine whether the quote is published in the yearbook. If you do not follow the guidelines below, your quote will not be included in the yearbook on the senior quotes page. If you are unsure as to whether or not your quote will be acceptable, please check with the yearbook adviser, Mr. Carr, in room A209 or email him at dcarr2@dentonisd.org, since we have yearbook printing deadlines to meet, the staff will not have time to return your quote to you for revision.

Remember

- Submit your quote (including spaces and punctuation marks) using the google form available below (and at <http://braswellmedia.org/seniorquotes>) before December 2, 2022 at 4:10pm.

Guidelines for Senior Quotes

All Quotes need to follow the Guidelines below. Failure to follow guidelines will result in the exclusion of your quote.

- All quotes must be limited to the allotted characters/spaces (180 characters). Yes, spaces between words count and need to be included
- All quotes must follow the Denton ISD and Braswell High School Student Code of Conduct and Student Handbook
- NO acronyms
- NO profanity, slang, obscene, offensive or inappropriate language
- NO references to cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, sex, gangs, gang-affiliated words or phrases and or cliques
- NO language that denigrates another person's ethnicity, religious/ political beliefs, sexuality, gender, physical or mental ability etc.
- NO derogatory comments about Denton ISD, Braswell High School, students, faculty or staff members
- NO shout-outs to or about other students or teachers. This rule is in place because of the potential of a quote offending the person it references. We do not have the time to check and keep records of who does and does not approve of being mentioned in another student's quote
- NO student or faculty may be quoted in the yearbook. There are many great quotes that can be reflective of you, you will find them
- All quotes should include attribution, when possible
- Your quote must be in Standard English. NO abbreviations, NO creative spelling or questionable/inappropriate content – anything unknown to the yearbook adviser may be removed
- All quotes are subject to review by the yearbook staff/adviser (and administration, if needed). Failure to follow guidelines will result in the exclusion of your quote

Due to the volume of students, not all quotes may be included in the yearbook. We have a limited amount of space. Please submit early – first come, first served.
